UMANGLAI

Umanglai is the primeval being and ancestral deities who bred and nourished us as the early human. The word "Umanglai" comes as a corruption from "Uramlai" i.e. gods who were once visible but become invisible and no longer seen. According to the Leisemlon (creation theory and beliefs of the Meitei), it was the gods who first settled on the earth and they were followed by human beings as their off-spring. And so the ancestral gods who were our progenitors are known as "Umanglai" who are worshipped by us in deep veneration now. Another interesting thing is that some kings who had extraordinary qualities and great virtues are deified and worshipped as Umanglai. So, Umanglai are 364 in numbers and they are worshipped very solemnly. Stories stand testimony that such worships of the Umanglai started before the historical period of 33 AD.

Now devotional services to these guardian gods are performed annually without fail. Not only the Meitei but other indigenous communities settling the region also install Umanglai and perform devotional services. In certain places Umanglai Haraoba (pleasing of Umanglai through a ritual celebration) cannot be performed without the initial offering of fruits and flowers by a certain tribal ethnic groups of Manipur. When the ritual celebration is performed events connected with and based on the relation of hill and valley of Manipur are also shown clearly. The gods were the most important and only common ancestral gods of the early Meitei and other indigenous tribes of Manipur. Many unavoidable relationships among the indigenous ethnic groups form the spirit of the celebrations of the gods. As for the Meitei, their life, sociology and history are inextricably woven in the Umanglai cult. Over and above paying devotional services to the Umanglai, the Meitei in times of their marriages, as a practice have to offer something to the Umanglai by

the male or female who are going to be married. The Umanglai have a set of regulations relating to the tradition of the society, discipline, moral codes, restrictions and permissions. If one wants to understand the social norms and culture of a Meitei village or an area, it can be easily be done after a thorough study and understanding of the stories and lore of the Umanglai. Thus, the Umanglai has been adored and worshipped as a very important God from times immemorial till today. In times of illness, serious competitions, examinations and conflicts, Umanglai is worshipped by the indigenous people so that they may be blessed with success and prosperity. It is a practice of the Indigenous people to keep Umanglai in the innermost corner of their heart to protect them from sorrows and sufferings.

SAGEI APOKPA

Sagei Apokpa/ Sagei Lai, the deified clan ancestors of the Meitei are very important gods. Among the Meitei, there are various clans for each of which deified clan ancestors are worshipped. These clan gods are supposed to be departed forefathers of the said clan. They are worshipped in reverence with this belief. Devotional services are thus performed to please them. They are not kept permanently at a fixed single spot. There is a tradition that the clan is to be split or divided into three. The first belongs to the eldest one, the second for middle one and the third for the youngest sibling. So, there are three different places of worship for each of these three. Not only this, some places of worship are kept at the convenient places in consideration of transport and conveyance. Normally devotional services for the clan ancestors are performed at the places assigned for it by the group. But, exceptions are also there where a single family worships it in the place of their own. The main purpose of worshipping the deified clan ancestors is based on the belief that when a person is faced with miseries and defeats in whatever he/she does, if the clan gods are worshipped they save the person from

such catastrophes and sufferings and word-off the hurdles and dangers in what they do. Having great faith in this, even temples are built to worship them.

INGKHOL LAI

The Meiteis have great faith in the worship of gods. Among these, worshipping of the Umanglai and deified clan ancestors along with the *Ingkhol Lai* (deities in-charge of the home-steads) are also important ones. The Meitei when going out of the house as a rule prays first to the Lainingthou Sanamahi (household god) and Ima Leimarel (Mother of Sanamahi). On reaching the courtyard they would pray again to the home-stead deity and after crossing the gate comes the turn of paying to the Umanglai protecting the village. The Meiteis keep a small temple for the deity in-charge of the home-steads. According to this tradition, each and every home-stead keeps a temple where devotional services are offered annually or monthly or daily as the case may be. Among such persons who keep small temples in their home-steads, are some who are possessed by spirits. Such home-stead deities are among others- Pakhangba, Nongpok Ningthou and Panthoibi, Mangang, Luwang and khuman Apokpa. The important belief associated with the keeping of these temples with deities inside and the worshipping of them is to protect the house owner from ill-luck, dangers and evil spells that may cast by some spirits who might think that their domain has been trespassed and disturbed. Construction of the temple for the spirits is a devotional way of asking them to offer good luck and success to the owners of the home-steads so that they may live in peace and harmony. In short, the philosophy behind it is that the spirits should stay peacefully in their abode and the human being should stay happily in prosperity in their realm within the precincts of the homestead.
